The Waldorf Campus originated from the **Demeter farm**Meinklang, which provided the financial backbone for the nonprofit organization. Angela and Werner Michlits founded the
school in 2011 out of a desire to share their view of the biodynamic
cultivation of the farm and their encounters with nature and the
social environment with their children in the field of education.

They found in Waldorf education an awareness of the need to enable each person to grow up in freedom, open to the world and close to life in a stable environment.

Founded as a bilingual village school (German-Hungarian) on a small farm in Pamhagen, they inspired many with their passion, courage, perseverance and love for the project for their own and all other children.



Facts and figures for the 2024/25 school year

- About 80 children
- 3 lage-extended kindergarten group
- S lst 8th grade in mixed-age classes
- 2 kindergarten teachers, 5 class teachers and several subject teachers
- 2 foreign languages from Year 1: English and Hungarian
- Wind ensemble from Year 5 for the entire middle school
- Art, Music and playing the recorder from Year 1
- Gardening and Wood working from Year 5

Our foundation: Waldorf education!

- Holistic approach: Waldorf education emphasizes the holistic development of children. It takes into account not only the intellectual aspect, but also artistic, social and emotional development.
- Art and creativity: Art, music, crafts and movement are important components of the curriculum. Pupils are encouraged to discover and express their creative abilities.
- **Teachers as companions:** Waldorf teachers in Waldorf schools accompany pupils on their learning journey. They often stay with the same pupils for several years and develop a close relationship with them.
- Rhythm and seasons: The Waldorf curriculum follows a rhythm based on the seasons. This includes the celebration of festivals and rituals linked to the cycles of nature.
- Free play and imagination: Waldorf education emphasizes free play and imagination. Pupils have time to express themselves and pursue their own interests.

 Overall, the Waldorf approach aims to foster pupils' individual development, creativity and social responsibility.



Location and landscape

- On the northern shore of Lake Neusiedl
- on a 10,000m² property on the edge of Neusiedl am See
- within a short driving distance of Vienna (40 min), Bruck (25 min), Eisenstadt (25 min), Sopron and Bratislava (35 min)
- within walking distance of Neusiedl am See railway station via sheltered footpath without road traffic
- unobstructed view of the Leitha Mountains and the natural landscape
- directly on the B10 cycle path (cycle route around the lake) and the cherry blossom path (along the Leitha Mountains)
- only 5 minutes to the lake (sailing, surfing...),
- a few meters to a riding stable
- in the middle of the nature park –
 UNESCO world heritage

GOAL 1:

- •Expansion of afternoon classes
- •Stable team and reorganization for growth of the association
- •Construction of the new Waldorf Campus Pannonia with event hall: start of construction May 2024 / completion summer 2025
- Marketing, sponsorship and promotion concept

The new building

... we create space for education ...

The design idea of the school has always been to create a place of shelter and exchange. School, crafts and art can unfold here.

The **village concept** with a center ultimately resulted in an ensemble of smaller buildings in the style of the **Burgenland Streckhof architecture**, which are arranged along the property around the main hall and with a large area for landscaping to open up to the site.


Children learn with all their senses. In our newly created learning space, we want to harness the power of nature and use **natural building materials** to create an environment that encourages creativity and joy of life. The building project has been implemented in timber construction, **untreated wooden** surfaces, plaster structures in natural colors, tiles and green roofs find their place.

The idea of a place of encounter in Neusiedl was always an important approach in all planning.

September 2025	Opening






